Dear Year 13 Students and their Parent and Guardians

Today the government has released details explaining what they will do to award grades to Yr 13 students this year now that exams have been cancelled. They have produced an information booklet and a letter for students, both of which we have attached to this email please could you share this with your son or daughter. Please take the time to read them.

In summary, the government has asked schools to provide a centre assessment grade for each subject and to rank order students within each grade. They have also made it clear that students will not be asked to complete any additional work for these assessments or complete any coursework (NEAs) which are incomplete. As a result, we will not be setting any further GCSE or A level work for Yr 13 students from today.

I hope having this information will help you to have a safe and restful Easter holiday.
